and because every family is different, your case manager will work with you and your family to understand your unique needs to provide customized support.

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Help for Kinship Caregivers in Prince George's County

We provide counseling and supportive services to families members such as grandparents, aunts, uncles, sisters and brothers who are caring for a relative's child or children. While PLC's case managers work with families to identify personal goals, it is our goal to:

- provide emotional support to families
- help families develop a sense of independence,
- prevent foster care placement,
- encourage family unity,
- reduce dependence on public assistance.

Our Mission is to train and empower families to tap their inner strengths and abilities and to advocate for and enhance the family unit through the use of natural and community resources.

Program Referrals are easy and there are may ways to connect to our services. You can even refer yourself. We also receive referrals from the County's Department of Social Services (DSS), Department of Family Services (DFS), Office on Aging, Prince George's County Public Schools, and other organizations serving children, youth and families.

Criteria for Participation:

- participants must reside in Prince George's County,
- the child or children must reside with the participant and be 18 years old or younger,
- participants must allow the assigned case manager weekly home visits,
- participants must share relevant family information with their case manager,
- participation must be voluntary, and participants must take part in planning and goal attainment.

Families who have participated in PLC's Kinship Care Supports are better equipped to continue raising children in their care if the biological parents are unwilling or unable due to addiction, domestic violence, incarceration, unemployment, illness or other crises.
