**Question and Answers**

**Are the maximum amounts noted in the RFA the finalized budget for each programming category or is there flexibility to increase these amounts?**

Yes, the amounts are final. The budget amounts were predetermined based on several factors including resources available to support each programming area.

**Do you foresee offering cosmetology at the Achievement Centers?**

Programming offered at the Achievement Centers is determined through needs and interests' assessments. For cosmetology to be offered at the Achievement Center, assessments must indicate it as a need and or an interest of the youth.

**Do the Achievement Centers have personal computers (PCs) for youth to completed on-line activities?**

Yes

**Can materials used to implement a program's curriculum be paid through the grant?**

Yes. These materials should be included as a line item on the budget template and details regarding its use (why it is needed) should be included in the budget narrative.

**I notice reference to Philantrack (section 3.1) and an application portal (section 3.1) HOWEVER, the rest of the RFA states that our application should be submitted as one document emailed to [applications@plcntu.org](mailto:applications@plcntu.org). Which method should we follow? If it's the application portal, where do we gain access to that portal?**

**Can an organization submit an application in more than one category – specifically for both a year-long category and a quarterly category?**

Applicants can only apply in either the year-long or quarterly category.
