Are the maximum amounts noted in the RFA the finalized budget for each programming category or is there flexibility to increase these amounts?

Yes, the amounts are final. The budget amounts where predetermined based on several factors including resources available to support each programming area.

## Do you foresee offering cosmetology at the Achievement Centers?

Programming offered at the Achievement Centers is determined through needs and interests' assessments. For cosmetology to be offered at the Achievement Center, assessments must indicate it as a need and or an interest of the youth.

Yes. These materials should be included as a line item on the budget template and details regarding its use (why it is needed) should be included in the budget narrative.

Can an organization submit an application in more than one category – specifically for both a year-long category and a quarterly category?
